 - 1. Have a friend from Ethiopia that is here visiting and he introduced him to Kim and she has really shown him a lot in order to help better his school and create a sister school for NSCA in Ethiopia

- i. EAC Update
 - 1. SB182 (School Discipline) failed, Mr. Coppin was not needed for testimony on that bill
- ii. UBG had a meeting with us last week to try and figure out a plan for possibly building our own gym
 - 1. UBG is giving us several proposals that we can look at and act on
- iii. Our refinance looks promising, our call date has already occurred so we are looking into options for us moving forward
 - 1. We are looking at options for improvements including atrium lighting, HVAC, parking lot resurfacing

 - d. Due to this influx, we are conducting a deep clean disinfection/sanitizing on Friday afternoon and the building will be off limits to staff this weekend to allow the disinfection to stay for at 48 hours
- v. We found out today at 1:00 pm that we are a National Showcase School for Capturing Kids Hearts for the 2nd year in a row!
 - 1. Out of 1,000 schools, only 324 schools won the award

- There are currently 16 positions open for Spanish teachers around the city, so at this time we don't believe we would be able to hire a quality teacher for next year
- In order to purchase curriculum for science for grades K-2, it would cost around \$18,000
- This class would give us a savings of roughly \$14,000 which would be a great way to help our budget for curriculum next year

Mr. Downey:

- I think the proposal is outstanding, this could help a portion of students who are not meant for 2-year or 4-year schools, but those who might be better at skilled trades
- Would field trips be included?
 - o Ms. Berndsen: Yes!
- Would this tie into the Science Fair?
 - o Ms. Berndsen: Yes! I would love to collaborate with them on that.
- b. 2021-2022 Homeschool Program Presentation (Mrs. Van Wieren, Mr. Dinnel, Mr. Zelasko)

 Mrs. Van Wieren:
 - We have currently 22 students enrolled
 - There are great reviews from parents and families
 - In order to make the program available next year, we need to have 25 students

Mr. Dinnel:

- Offering unique programs for schools, as well as homeschool programs
- Met with Mark Hyatt to determine some of the programs
- Programs possibly offered:
 - Front Range Construction Academy
 - Partnered with Home Builders Association
 - This would be marketed/educated by my people
 - Cost would be \$3,300 per student (PPR would be roughly \$4,200 per student for homeschool enrollment)
 - This
 - o Sports Management Program
 - Primarily focused on high school students
 - Exposure into coaching
 - Exposure in venues to see what it takes to coach in venues for events
 - Agribusiness and Equine Science
 - The standards are specific to the agriculture industry
 - How do things work, how does the world work?
 - Partners with area farms/dairy farms to expose kids on the functions of a farm and how to manage the animals
 - Partnered with the Pueblo Zoo, since this program is launching their in August
 - K-12 program
 - Alpine International Prep Academy
 - K-12 program

 Outdoor education – NSCA would not have to house this program, it would be an off-sight program

Mr. Downey:

- Could we have multiple programs offered?
 - o Mr. Dinnel: Yes. I would like to promote the programs with one school and students can choose which track they would like to take

Mr. Dinnel:

We would need 10-15 kids in each program before it would be a viable option
